Drawings **must incorporate the contest theme**. All artwork must be original, and on **8 1/2 in. x 11 in. paper.**

7th-8th grades	300-400 words
9th-10th grades	400-500 words
11th-12th grades	400-500 words

Essays will be judged on general organization, grammar, clarity of message, originality and **must incorporate the theme**
