After completing Launch, you will have your choice of attending the **Oregon Right to Life Conference** on **April 6, 2019** in **Tualatin, OR**, or the **National Right to Life Convention**. Registration and lodging is provided by Oregon Right to Life Education Foundation. You will be responsible for travel costs and meals, (registration for the events will include some meals).
