In Oregon, abortion is legal until birth. The same baby who hears music and feels pain can be aborted for any reason. For most Oregonians, limiting late-term abortion is common sense. But not for pro-abortion politicians in Salem.

That's not all. CDC data shows that as many as 143 babies have tragically died after failed abortions. In Oregon, there are no laws requiring medical care for a baby who survives an abortion.
