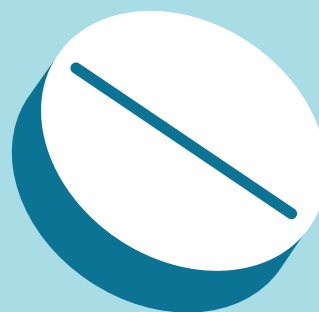

TEENAGER/ADULT

Q: What is the most common method of abortion – chemical or surgical?

A: Chemical abortion

Also known as the abortion pill or RU-486. It is responsible for over 60% abortions in the US. 10.93% of women experience a serious adverse event like hemorrhage or infection within 45 days after taking the abortion pill. It has a complication rate 4x that of surgical abortion and is very dangerous for women with ectopic pregnancies (which make up 1-2% of human pregnancies).

Direct to abortion pill handout and/or abortion procedures display.

True or false: The abortion pill can be reversed.

A: True.

In 64–68% of cases, the abortion pill can be reversed if bioidentical progesterone is taken within 72 hours of taking the first pill and before taking the second pill. Over six thousand babies have been born healthy and safe because of abortion pill reversal. This can be accessed by visiting abortionpillreversal.com

True or False: Oregon has more laws protecting babies in their mommy's tummy than most other states.

A: False.

Most other states have better laws protecting babies before they are born.

Q: Are there laws in Oregon that protect babies before they are born?

A: No.

There are no laws in Oregon that protect babies before they are born. We think there should be, and that's what we talk to people about!

TEENAGER/ADULT

True or False: The overturning of Roe v. Wade made abortion illegal in the United States.

A: False.

The Dobbs decision that overturned Roe v. Wade returned the power to regulate abortion to the states. Abortion is regulated on a state-by-state basis, and here in Oregon, abortion is legal until birth for any reason, which most pro-choice people disagree with.

Q: How many European countries permit abortion on demand without gestational limits? Zero, six, or ten?

A: Zero.

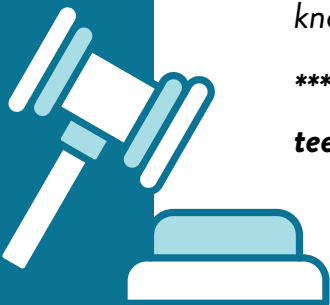
Zero European countries permit abortion on demand without gestational limits. In contrast, Oregon law permits abortion until birth for any reason, which most pro-choice people disagree with.

Q: *What can a 16-year-old do in Oregon without the consent of a parent or guardian? Go to an R-rated movie, get a tattoo, or get an abortion?**

A: Get an abortion

In fact, parents can be made to pay for an abortion with their insurance without knowing what they are paying for.

*****This question is best for parents and older people. Do not ask this question of teenagers unless you already know that they are pro-life.**

Q: How many diapers does a brand-new baby use in a day? Five, ten, or fifteen?

A: Ten

That's a lot of diapers! That's why we are telling people about pregnancy resource centers where moms can get free diapers and baby supplies.

Q: Can you take pictures of babies before they are born?

A: Yes!

Ultrasounds are used to see babies before they are born, and you can get pictures and videos of the baby. Moms can get free ultrasounds at a pregnancy resource center!

TEENAGER/ADULT

Q: How many diapers will the average baby use in the first year after being born? 2,000, 2,500, or 3,000?

A: 2,500!

That's a lot of diapers! That's why we're telling people about pregnancy resource centers that help provide diapers, wipes, and other baby supplies so that moms are supported.

Give them a Find Your Care card and let them know that if they or anyone they know ever needs pregnancy help, they can visit one of the listed resources.

Q: What is one free service that pregnancy resource centers provide?

A: (any of the following): pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, parent education, mentoring, diapers, formula, baby clothes, pregnancy loss support, fatherhood coaching

Tell them about the resources available, give a Find Your Care card, and let them know that if they or anyone they know ever needs pregnancy help, they can visit one of the listed resources.



CHILD

Q: Can you show me how big you were when your heart started beating?

Indicate the size of a sesame seed.

Your heart started beating at approximately 22 days old when you were smaller than a grain of rice!

Direct to heartbeat phone.

Q: Do you like to dance? How old were you when you started to move around inside your mommy's tummy?

A: Only seven and a half weeks old!

Q: Are you right-handed or left-handed? How big were you when you started using that hand?

Indicate the size of a 10-week fetus.

You were only ten weeks old when you started using your right (or left) hand to touch your face, suck your thumb, etc.

TEENAGER/ADULT

Q: How long did you remain a single cell? 3 hours, 30 hours, or 3 days?

A: 30 hours.

From the moment of fertilization, you were a living, unique human being and only one cell for about 30 hours!

Direct to fetal development information and/or fetal models.

Q: How old were you when you started favoring your right or left hand? 8 weeks, 10 weeks, or 12 weeks?

A: 10 weeks

At 10 weeks, you started using your dominant hand to scratch your face and suck your thumb!

Direct to fetal development information and/or fetal models.

Q: How old were you when your heart started beating?

A: Approximately 22 days after fertilization (6 weeks gestational age)

Direct to heartbeat phone.

Q: Take a deep breath! How big were you when you first practiced breathing?

Indicate the size of a 13-week fetus.

By 13 weeks, you were doing breathing exercises to prepare for life outside of mommy's tummy.

Direct to fetal models.

Q: By the time you were 16 weeks old in the womb, your heart had been beating for about 10 weeks. Can you guess how many beats that is?

A: Approximately 15,800,000 times!

Q: Do you have a favorite food? How big were you when you started having a favorite food?

Indicate the size of a 16-week fetus.

By 16 weeks, you were developing taste buds, and you started picking out your favorite foods!

Direct to fetal models.

Q: Sing “Head, Shoulders, Knees, & Toes.” Can babies hear before they are born?

A: Yes!

At 22 weeks, babies move after hearing loud, low-pitched noises such as a father's voice!

Direct to fetal development information and/or fetal models.

TEENAGER/ADULT

Q: When can a fetus feel pain? (Hint: It's between 13-26 weeks)

A: 15 weeks.

We know for sure that a fetus can feel pain by 15 weeks, but it's possible that they feel it sooner.

Direct to fetal development information and/or fetal models.

Q: When do we know that a fetus can recognize tastes? (Hint: It's between 13-26 weeks)

A: 16 weeks.

The food a woman eats flavors the amniotic fluid in the womb, and at 16 weeks, a fetus can taste flavors and recognize them.

Direct to fetal development information and/or fetal models.

Q: Can babies make faces inside their mommy's tummy?

A: Yes!

Babies can make faces if they are startled or in pain starting at 31 weeks gestational age. What's the silliest face you can make?

Direct to fetal models.

Q: What's the worst smell you've ever smelled? How big were you when you started to smell things while you were still in mommy's tummy?

Indicate the size of a 28-week fetus.

You were 28 weeks old! At 28 weeks, you started to smell different odors in mommy's tummy.

Direct to fetal models.

Q: Can babies respond to light before they are born?

A: Yes!

Have you ever held a flashlight on your hand and seen it glow red? That's kind of like what a baby can see if you put a flashlight on the mom's tummy. By 29 weeks, babies can track light if it's moving and even notice when the light changes!

Direct to fetal models.

TEENAGER/ADULT

What is the last major organ to mature in a developing fetus? The kidneys, lungs, or heart?

A: Lungs.

The lungs mature around 34-weeks gestation.

Q: 92% of premature babies survive if they are born after how many weeks?

A: 28 weeks.

However, the youngest baby to survive a premature birth was born at only 21-weeks gestation!

Q: When can a fetus respond to light?

A: 31 weeks.

They can track light if it's moving and even notice when light changes! This happens by 31-weeks gestation.
